

## **Frequently Asked Questions about LTNA Scholarship Applications**

**Q. What is the deadline for submitting an LTNA Scholarship application?**

A. The postmark deadline for submitting completed applications, supporting documents and certified transcripts is May 31st. **No exceptions.**

Applications, supporting documents and transcripts received after the May 31st deadline with a postmark date later than May 31st or *with no postmark* date will not be considered.

**Q. Is there a minimum GPA requirement?**

A. Yes.

A minimum grade point average of 3.0 in a 4-point grading system, or a minimum overall grade point average of “B” in any grade-point system is required. No exceptions. The scholarship application environment is competitive. LTNA scholarship award recipients typically demonstrate a record of academic excellence.

**Q. Is there a field of study requirement?**

A. Yes.

Competition for LTNA scholarships is limited to students accepted to or enrolled in a *full-time curriculum* at an accredited institution of higher learning in a bachelor's degree program in the field of supply-chain logistics. No exceptions.

**Q. How are LTNA scholarship winners selected?**

A. LTNA Scholarship Trustees assess applications on the following criteria:

1. GPA (certified transcript)
2. Field of Study (verification)
3. Community Involvement, Extracurricular Activities and Honors/Awards
4. Written Essay (500 words)
5. Letters of Recommendation (3)

**Q. When are LTNA scholarship award recipients announced?**

A. Scholarship award winners will be contacted by phone. Only scholarship award recipients will be contacted.

**Q. Can I apply for an LTNA scholarship if I have already graduated from high school or am currently enrolled in a qualifying undergraduate field of study?**

A. Yes.

As long as you plan to attend, or currently attend, an accredited junior college, college or university in a qualifying undergraduate field of study, you may apply for an LTNA scholarship.

However, if you have not yet begun undergraduate study, you must enclose with your LTNA scholarship application a formal letter of acceptance from the admissions office of the university to which you are planning to attend. No exceptions

**Q. I applied for an LTNA scholarship last year and was not selected as a scholarship award recipient. Can I apply again this year?**

A. Yes, provided that you meet all current eligibility requirements and meet the application submission postmark deadline of May 31st.

**Q. Can I submit employment reviews or class profiles, etc., for consideration?**

A. No. LTNA Scholarship Trustees wish to receive only the specified application and supporting documents.

**Q. Can I send a copy of my official transcript?**

A. No

LTNA Scholarship Trustees will consider only certified transcripts that are received directly from the applicant's high school, college or university.

Transcripts must be postmarked by May 31st. No exceptions.

**Q. Is the scholarship award made payable to the student or to the university?**

A. The scholarship award funding is made directly to the university on behalf of the student. No exceptions.

**Q. Does LTNA provide any expenses for air transportation, hotel accommodations, meals or conference fees if I want to attend the LTNA Annual Scholarship Awards ceremony?**

A. No.
